Introduction and Objectives (2mins)

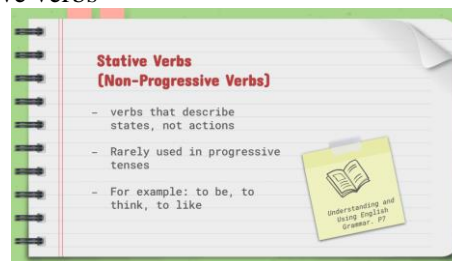
- Students will review their understanding of the content that has been covered so far through a quick pop quiz by testing their knowledge.
